



Maples Monarchs 2010 Baseball Registration Information

** Parents, all **NEW** baseball registrations must be accompanied with a copy of your child's proof of birth date (i.e. birth certificate or Manitoba Health Card).

Age Groups and Registration Fees (NO INCREASES THIS YEAR)

03, 04 and 05	Rally Cap	\$50 Registration Fee. (5, 6 and 7 years old)
01, 02 and 03	Peanut	\$80 Registration Fee. (7, 8 and 9 years old)
99 and 100	Mosquito	\$115 Registration Fee. (10 and 11 years old)
97 and 98	Peewee	\$150 Registration Fee. (12 and 13 years old)
95 and 96	Bantam	\$165 Registration Fee. (14 and 15 years old)
92, 93 and 94	Midget	\$180 Registration Fee. (16, 17 and 18 years old)

Baseball player registration fees are used to cover the following expenses:

- Team registration fees (NWMBA) fees.
- Umpire Fees.
- \$10 Field Usage Fee (City of Winnipeg).
- Wind-up subsidy.
- Team hats, jerseys and pants.
- Baseballs, bats and bases.
- Catchers Equipment.
- Community Club expenses for Sports Programs.

Maples will continue our practice of collecting a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) Uniform Damage Deposit which must be paid before a Uniform will be issued to a player. This deposit will be refunded upon the return of the Jersey and Pants in acceptable condition to the Community Centre within 30 days of your last game. Failure to comply could result in the loss of this deposit. The past practice of a \$25 deposit resulted in Uniforms not being returned until well into the winter or not at all.

The Maples Hardball program will continue to follow the Maples Standing Finance Committee Transfer Fee policy. All players registered at our Centre that are later transferred to another Centre will be refunded their registration fees. Players transferred into our Centre, will pay their full registration fee at our Centre and will be redirected to their Centre for reimbursement of their initial registration fees. There will no longer be any transferring of fees between Maples and other Centre's.

Recreation Baseball Season and Playoffs

Rally Cap	To be determined. (Tuesday and Thursday)
Peanut	10 game seasons. (Monday and Wednesdays)
Mosquito	12 game seasons. (Tuesday and Thursdays)
Peewee	14 game seasons. (Monday and Wednesdays)
Bantam	16 game seasons.
Midget	18 game seasons.

The regular baseball season for Recreation Baseball typically starts near the beginning of May and ends near the end of June. (Rally Cap play starts at least one week later) Most games will be Monday through Thursday, with some Friday and Sunday night games. All games will start at 6:30.

Rally Cap and Peanut age groups will only play against other teams in the Seven Oaks, North Winnipeg and Midland area. The Mosquito and Peewee age groups will play against teams in our area as well as St. James. Peewee AA and Bantam A play in our area St. James and Winnipeg South. The Bantam AA and Midget will play against teams on a citywide basis. This is subject to change each year.

There will be A teams and an AA team for Mosquito, Peewee, Bantam and Midget. Last year Maples had a Midget AA and Bantam AA team. The balance of the teams were A teams. North Winnipeg Minor Baseball Association will determine which clubs will have a AA team. The major factors that will determine which clubs will have an A team, AA team or both are **number of Maples players on the team and if there is a Maples coach.**

We hope to field Maples teams in each age group. Tell your friends to get registered and get your parents to step forward and coach by the March 17th deadline. We have great coaching clinics (some are on-line), which can be helpful to even the novice coach.

There are local playoffs for the Mosquito, Peewee, Bantam and Midget age groups. These will take place during the latter part of June. (A Teams only)

There are city playoffs for Mosquito, Peewee, Bantam and Midget and they will be on July 3th and 4th. There is talk that the Bantam and Midget cities could be moved to July 10th and 11th. There are also provincial playoffs, which will be on July 16th, 17th and 18th. (AA teams only)

Maples KidPro Baseball Clinic

The Maples will host this clinic featuring Winnipeg Goldeyes players on May 22/10 for all Maples Registered Hardball players. You are required to register for this clinic under a separate cover. There will be no fee just a \$5.00 cash deposit to hold your spot, which will be refunded upon your attendance. Space is limited to the first 60 players registered for this clinic.
